Art Contest Theme: Beethoven's Fantastic Fifth!

Description: An area-wide art contest to connect students to the CCSO's Feb. 17, 2012 Education Concert program

6 Winning pieces of artwork will be selected:

- 3 from 4th grade entries
- 3 from 5th grade entries

Instructions:

- ♫ Play the music excerpt (provided by the CCSO) for the class.
- ♫ Students will create a drawing or collage based on the music excerpt ("Close your eyes and listen; pretend you're making a movie—what do you see?").
 - Drawings/sketches/paintings/collages must be **no larger than** 22" x 28" posterboard (no tri-folds, please) and should contain **no loose parts** or **heavy pieces**. Fabric, pictures, artwork, etc. may be used to create the collage; please be tasteful and respectful in your creative work.
- ♫ Please have each student label the back of his/her story ending with: student's name, the homeroom teacher's name, school/campus name.
- ♫ **Select the best piece of artwork** from each classroom. **Call the CCSO office at 882-2717** or **email Abby Janca (ajanca@ccsymphony.org)** to enter your class(es) in the contest; we will contact you to coordinate the pickup of your top entries.
- ♫ **Winners** will be announced at the Education Concerts.

 - Students must use 300 words or less
 - Clear, handwritten entries are preferred; computer-generated entries are also acceptable
- ♫ Please have each student label the back of his/her story ending with: student's name, the homeroom teacher's name, school/campus name.
